Be Still

PSALM 46:10 KJV

"Be still, and know that I am God: I will be exalted among the heathen, I will be exalted in the earth."

A SHORT REFLECTION

Waiting can create a constant urge to do something: make the decision, find the answer, or force an outcome. Psalm 46:10 does not ask us to deny what is happening. It invites us to pause long enough to remember that God is still God when the future is unclear. Stillness can be a faithful act: one breath, one prayer, one moment in which you stop carrying tomorrow.

REFLECT

What am I trying to force or control because uncertainty feels frightening?

RELEASE

What would it look like to place this one concern in God's hands for today?

TRUTH TO REMEMBER

Stillness does not mean God is inactive. It gives my heart room to remember who He is.

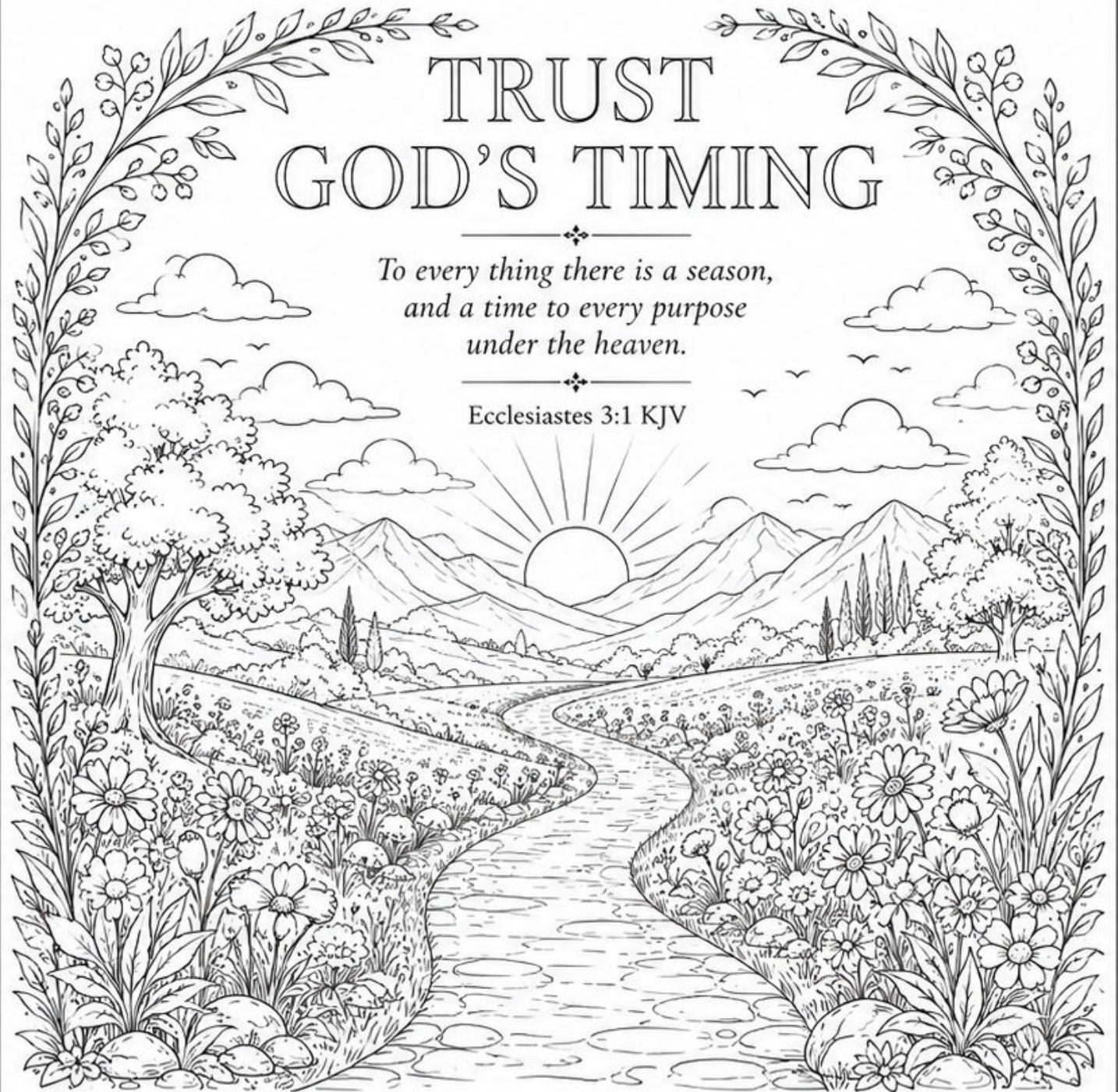
A PRAYER

Lord, quiet the part of me that believes I must solve everything today. Help me be still, remember who You are, and trust You with what I cannot yet see. Amen.

A SHORT REFLECTION

Waiting can make us feel forgotten, delayed, or left behind. But God's timing is never careless. Even when we do not understand the pace of this season, He is still ordering our steps with wisdom and purpose.

REFLECT:

Where am I struggling to trust God's timing instead of forcing my own?

TRUTH TO REMEMBER:

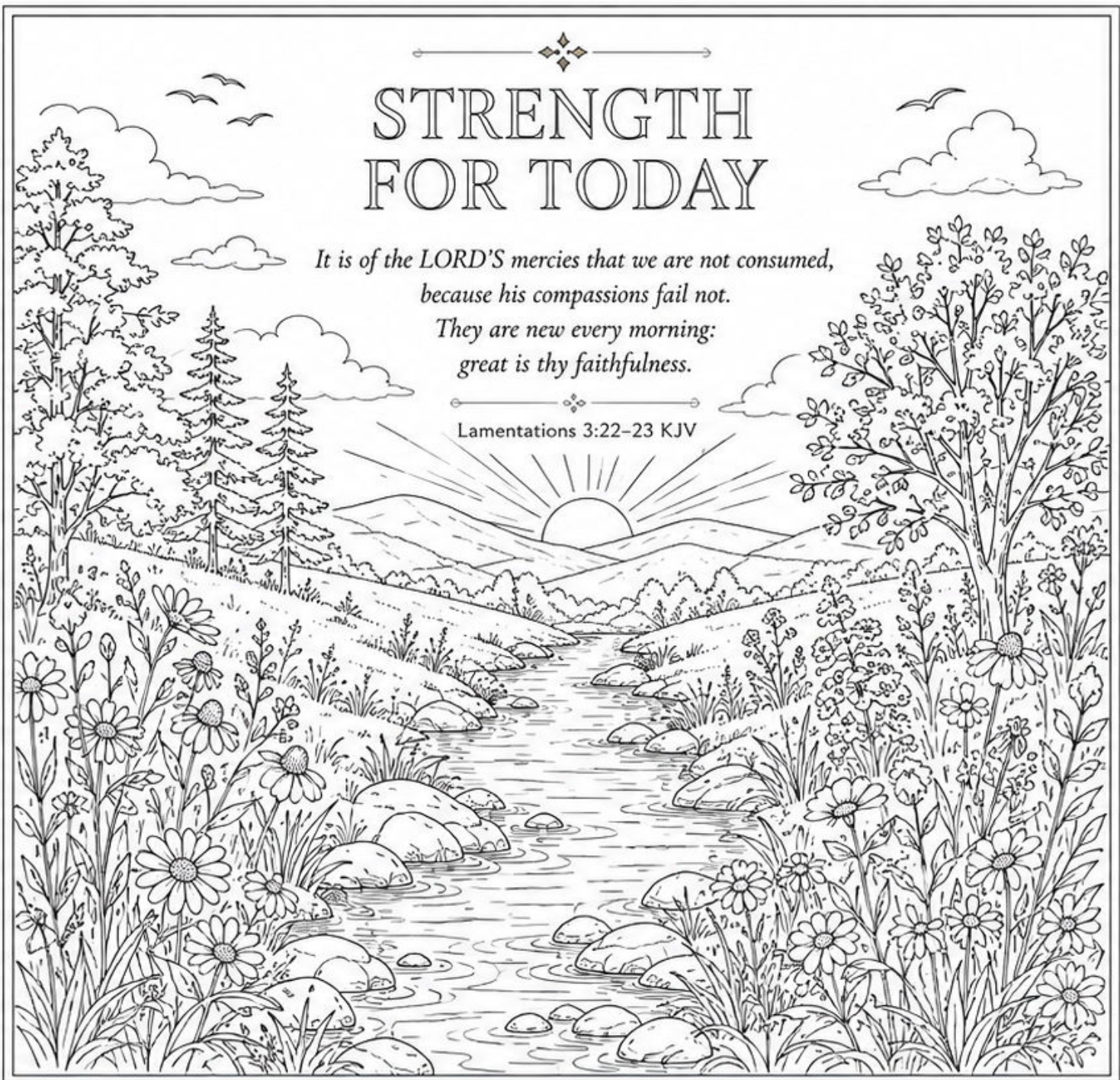
*God is not late.

A PRAYER:

Lord, thank You for mercies that are new every morning. Strengthen me for this day, and help me receive the grace You are providing right now. Amen.

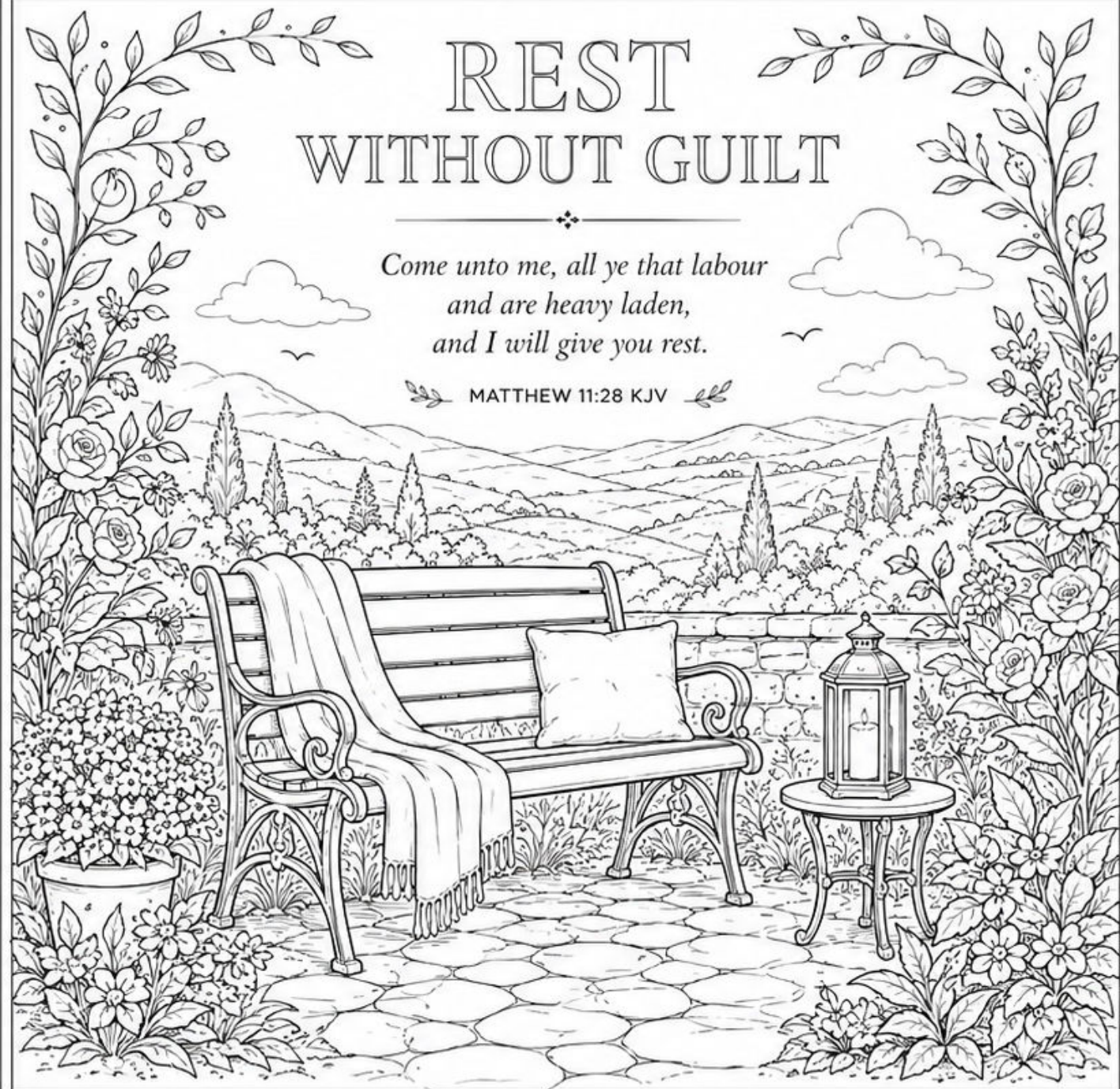

A SHORT REFLECTION

Rest is not laziness, and pausing does not make you less faithful. Jesus invites the weary to come to Him, not after they have earned rest, but because they need it.

REFLECT:

What keeps me from receiving rest as a gift from God?

TRUTH TO REMEMBER:

*Rest can be a faithful
response to weariness.*

A PRAYER:

Lord, I bring You my weariness. Help me receive rest without guilt and trust that You are present even when I pause. Amen.

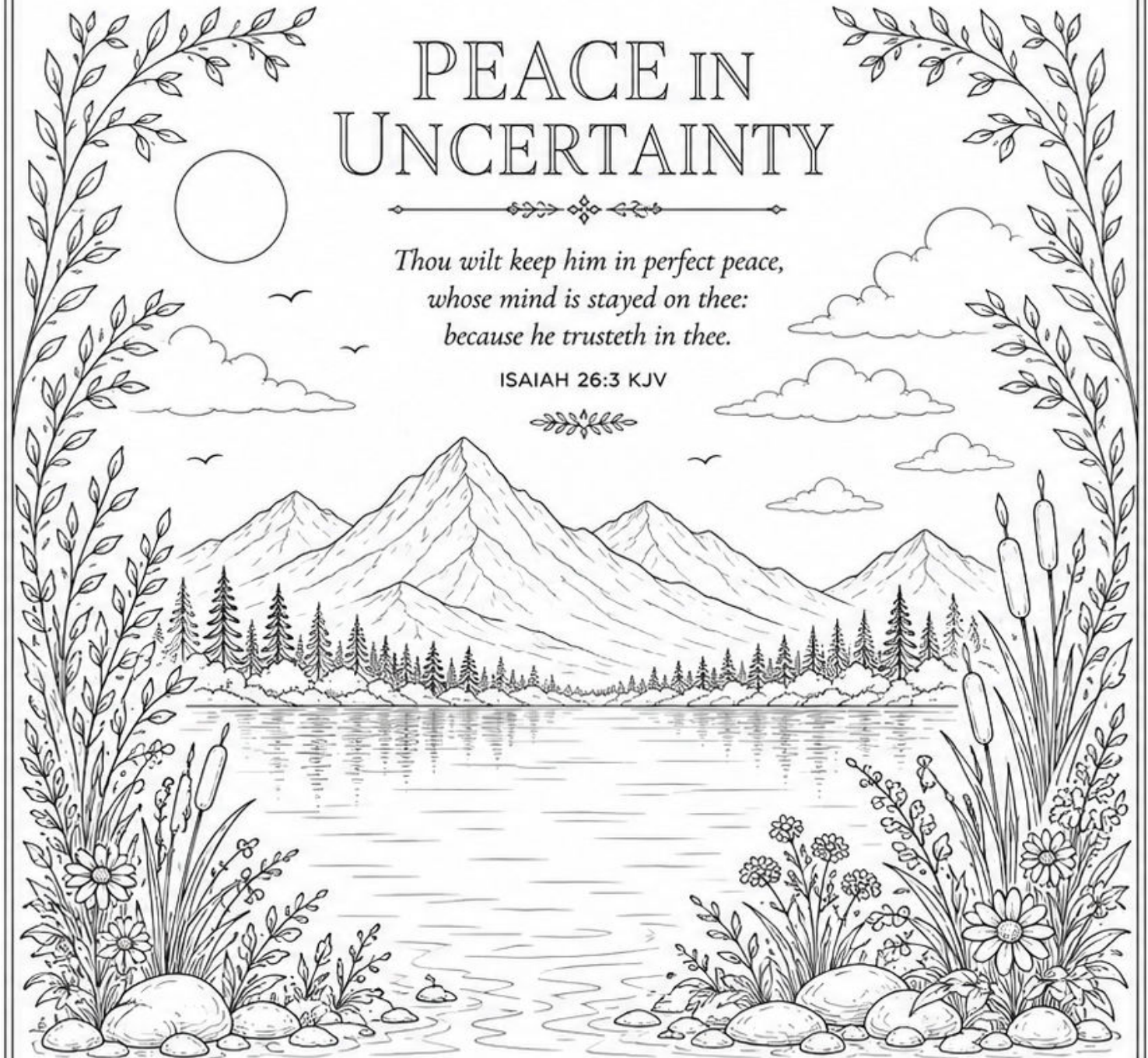

A SHORT REFLECTION

Peace does not require full understanding of what comes next. God steadies the heart that stays turned toward Him, even while the future remains unclear.

REFLECT:

Where do I need God's peace more than I need immediate answers?

TRUTH TO REMEMBER:

*God can keep my heart in peace
while I wait for clarity.*

A PRAYER:

*Lord, my mind is easily pulled toward
fear and uncertainty. Fix my thoughts on You,
and fill me with Your peace in this season. Amen.*

A SHORT REFLECTION:

REFLECT:

What promise or hope am I still asking God to help me hold onto?

TRUTH TO REMEMBER:

Hope can remain alive, even in a long season of waiting.

A PRAYER:

Lord, strengthen my hope while I wait. Keep me from despair,
and help me trust that what I cannot yet see is still in Your hands. Amen.

What God begins, He does not abandon.

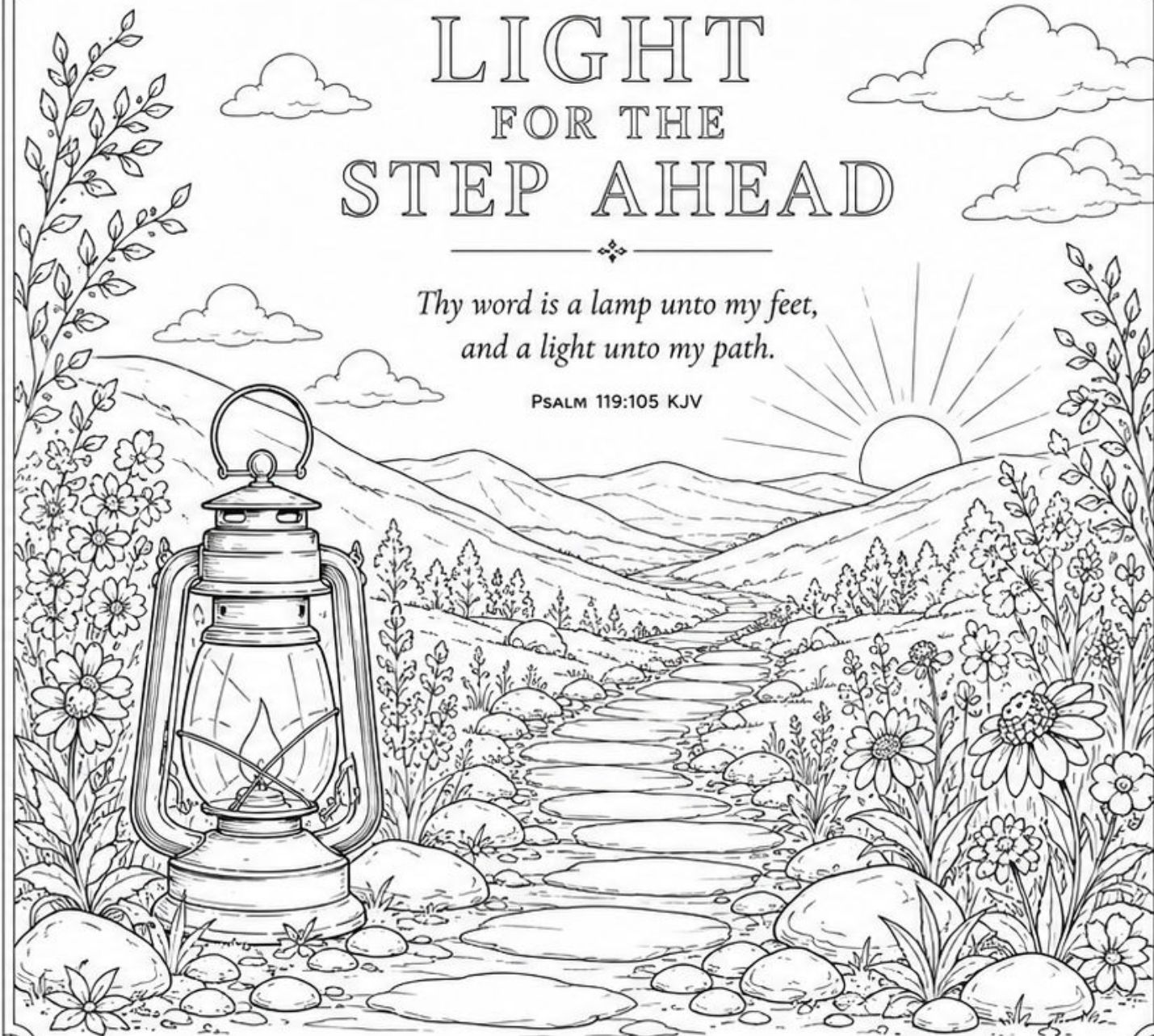
A PRAYER:
